

Decision No. 10
on the approval of the Baltic FAB Performance Plan
for the Reference Period 2 of the Performance Scheme

Adopted on 17 June 2014
Baltic Functional Airspace Block (Baltic FAB) Board

Having regard to the Agreement on the Establishment of the Baltic Functional Airspace Block between the Republic of Lithuania and the Republic of Poland (hereinafter called Baltic FAB Agreement), and in particular Article 25 thereof,

Having regard to the Baltic FAB Agreement, and in particular Article 23 paragraphs 2 and 3 thereof,

Acting in accordance with the procedure laid down in Baltic FAB Board Terms of Reference, adopted by the Baltic FAB Strategic Committee Decision No. 27 on 6th September 2012 in Warsaw, Poland

HEREBY TAKES THE FOLLOWING DECISIONS:

- To approve the Baltic FAB Performance Plan for the Reference Period 2 of the Performance Scheme, prepared by the Baltic FAB National Supervisory Authorities and issued on 16 June 2014;
- To task the Baltic FAB ANSPs involved in the Performance Scheme to implement the Baltic FAB Performance Plan for RP2 and Baltic FAB Performance Targets;
- To task the Baltic FAB Strategic, Economic and Performance Committee to perform regular (twice a year at least) reviews of the Baltic FAB Performance Targets implementation and the functioning of the Baltic FAB Performance Scheme;
- To task the Baltic FAB Strategic, Economic and Performance Committee to report directly to the Baltic FAB Board about inconsistencies in the proceedings of ANSPs involved in the Performance Scheme which may affect the measures and performance targets adopted in the Baltic FAB Performance Plan for RP2.
